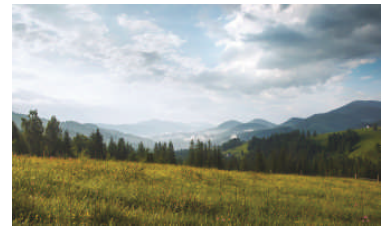


Photo Contest

Looking for striking photos that show the diversity of the PAMZ region!

Eligibility

The contest is open to all amateur photographers who reside or work in the PAMZ region. Photos must be from the PAMZ region. Staff and Board members of PAMZ are not eligible to enter the contest.

- Adult Division: Ages 18 and up
- Youth Division: Ages up to 18

Entries and Identification

A maximum of three (3) entries per person. An entry form **MUST** be completed to enter. The entry forms are available online at www.pamz.org. 1st (\$300), 2nd (\$200) & 3rd (\$100) place prizes will be awarded. Photos will be judged in the following 3 categories:

1. Atmosphere (clouds, storms, sunrises etc.)
 2. Environment (nature, landscapes etc.)
 3. Youth (Ages up to 18, Atmosphere & Environment)
- PAMZ appreciates all entries, but only contest winners will be contacted.

Submission Specifications

- Emailed entries must be sent in as JPEGs individually (one photograph and one entry form per e-mail).
- Do NOT group entries in one e-mail.
- Each photographic file cannot exceed 6 MB.
- Resolution – minimum of 300 dpi with a minimum of 1600 pixels wide for horizontal images or 1600 pixels for vertical images.
- Printed photos must be 5"x7" or "8x10" (unmounted).

Do not digitally enhance or alter photos (beyond basics needed for realistic color balance and sharpness). Low resolution prints or digital files that cannot be reproduced in high quality will be disqualified. Printed entries will not be returned. If people are in the photograph, model release forms are the responsibility of the entrant and must be submitted with all applicable photos. Forms are available online at www.pamz.org. Submissions will be judged based on composition and appropriateness to meet the categories of Atmosphere and Environment.

Publication

- Winners' names and photographs may be used for PAMZ's Annual Report.
- PAMZ reserves the non-exclusive right to publish any entry and/or use any entry in promotional material.

Deadline

All entries must be received by 4:00 p.m. on March 1, 2011.
